SENIOR EVENTS CONTRACT

Senior year has arrived, and the excitement is building! We want to ensure that all students who fulfill the graduation requirements enjoy the year.

Below are the criteria for full participation.

- 1. You must enter your senior year with at least 30 HS credits.
- 2. You must attend all classes and be on time. Seniors with more than three unexcused absences may be removed from any or all senior activities. Cutting class is an unexcused absence. Cutting class is also subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to being barred from any or all senior activities. This applies to all classes, HS and college.
- 3. You are expected to uphold appropriate and model behavior standards. Seniors will be held accountable to the <u>Citywide Behavioral Expectations</u>. Any senior with an infraction, specifically a Principal or Superintendent Suspension, will not be allowed to participate in senior activities and may be barred from graduation.
- 4. Payments are received on time. Please contact Ms. Moyano at moyano@queensinquiry.com if an issue arises or if your family cannot pay any of the dues.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: As per the Office of the Chancellor, and regardless of whether dues have been collected,

Consistent with the need to maintain standards and to communicate to students our expectations of them, only students who have successfully completed the requirements for a high school diploma, including course and standardized tests, will be permitted to participate in graduation ceremonies conducted by their schools.

Class of 2026 Senior Year Activities

Welcome to Senior Year 2026! You have waited and worked hard to reach this point, and we are excited and proud of you. Senior year can have many expenses, and some of them are Senior **Dues and Senior Activities**. (We encourage you to check in with your counselor and be sure you are graduating, as all dues are NON-REFUNDABLE!)

Senior Dues fees are as follows: **EVERYONE must pay senior dues.** They are \$250.00 plus an additional \$50 for your Senior Picture sitting fee. The sitting fee is due August 27th, the day of pictures. **The remaining \$250.0.00 should be Paid in FULL Due by September 30th 2025!** This includes the following.

- Yearbook
- Sweatshirt
- T-shirt
- Cap and Gown
- Diploma Case
- Graduation tickets and announcement
- Graduation Venue
- Senior Pictures (The additional \$50 to be given in the day of Senior Pictures, August 22nd)

Additional Senior ONLY activities (NOT INCLUDED IN SENIOR DUES):

This year, senior activities will take place throughout the year. Those activities will be determined by the beginning of the year.

Senior activities typically cost between \$20 - \$40 per event. Some events that we have had in the past are: ice skating, bowling, bingo, trampoline park, paint night and cookie decorating. These are just to name a few. Your Senior Committee will help to determine which events you would like to see happen for the year based on your feedback.

Prom

This year's Prom will be held on June 3rd. Prom typically costs \$150 per person. We are asking for a \$75 deposit to hold the venue. Once a final price is determined, those who are attending will be informed of the balance. The balance is subject to change based on DJ selection, photo booth / other attractions for prom.

The \$75 deposit is due by Monday, November 3rd.

Senior Trip:

This year's Senior Trip will be to Split Rock Resort in the Poconos, PA. We are looking to go from 1/12/26 through 1/14/26. The price is approximately \$400 per person with 4 people in a room. If there are fewer students in a room, the price increases. There is a sheet attached that details all that is included in the price. The initial deposit is due on 10/17/25 in the amount of \$100. The second payment of \$200 is due on 11/14/25 and the final remaining balance is due on 1/2/26. If we do not secure the minimum number of students for this trip (approximately 45), the other option is detailed below.

The alternate option is to do a day trip to Six Flags or Dorney Park. This typically costs about \$150 per person and includes transportation, admission to the park and one meal. If we then cannot secure the required amount of students for this trip (approximately 50), then there will not be a Senior Trip.
